The Daniel E. Koshland, Jr. Course Development Grant provides funds to cover specific expenses incurred by graduate student instructors to develop new features for their Reading and Composition classes. Examples include but are not limited to the following: guest speakers, field trips, teaching and grading software or applications. Grants will be awarded on the merits of the course development proposal and distributed on a rolling basis. All applications must contain: a complete application cover sheet, an account of what the funds will be used for, and an itemization of expenses. The award maximum is generally \$2,000. After the funds have been put to use, you should submit a one-page account, along with receipts for expenses, of what they helped you accomplish.
