Grant Application

The Daniel E. Koshland, Jr. Professional Self-Development Grant provides funds to cover specific expenses incurred by graduate students in the course of self-development as teachers of writing. Examples of appropriate self-development activities include but are not limited to the following: travel to the Conference on College Composition and Communication or other conferences on composition, books and refreshments for study groups on composition theory, purchase of and training in relevant online software or computer applications for your department. Grants will be awarded on the merits of the proposal and distributed on a rolling basis. All applications must contain: a complete application cover sheet, a brief description of what the funds will be used for, and an itemization of estimated expenses. The award maximum is generally \$2,000, but larger amounts will be considered. After the funds have been put to use, you should submit a one-page report, along with receipts for expenses, on what they helped you accomplish.
